

Step-by-step description: How to define own services with justpay



Once you register and sign-in with justpay:

1. Define the first SMS command (keyword):
 - a. Choose COMMAND section and then ADD NEW COMMAND;
 - b. Define the prefix and suffix – key words that the User will put in the contents of their SMS message.

2. On the next page choose the **method of connection with justpay service**. There are **3 methods** available, which differ in the way how access codes are generated and verified. Detailed documentation and examples of scripts are presented in CONNECTION METHODS section.

The most simple connection method is method 3; however, it is up to the Partner to decide about the method to be applied.

- a. **Method 1** – The Partner downloads code packs from justpay and then implements a chosen pack into its database. Having chosen this method the following parameters must be defined with justpay:
 - Number and tariff of SMS Premium to which the User will send SMS message,
 - Contents of the return SMS message,
 - Length of the code and volume of the code pack,
 - Acceptance of the command by clicking on ACCEPT and then ACTIVATE.

Once the command is defined, information is sent to service administrator about the activation of a new command. If the command is correct, it shall be activated within 1 business day (a relevant email is sent to the Partner).

- As soon as the command is accepted, a code pack is automatically generated and can be uploaded from CODES section;
- Every next code pack must be generated manually (GENERATE function in CODES section) – an individual code pack can be attached.

The Partner should:

- Upload the generated code pack from justpay website;
- Prepare a database chart;
- Import the prepared code pack;
- Prepare a script for SMS code verification;
- Integrate the Partner's www page with code verification.

- b. **Method 2** – The Partner prepares URL link in accordance with JustPay specification. When the User orders a code, justpay analyzes the URL description, generates a relevant link and uploads the code from the Partner (“knocks” with GET method onto the Partner’s server) who returns the generated code. When choosing this method, the following parameters must be defined with justpay:
- Number of SMS Premium to which the User shall send SMS;
 - Contents of the return SMS message;
 - Description of URL prepared by the Partner;
 - Finally the command should be accepted by clicking on ACCEPT and then ACTIVATE.

As soon as the command is defined, information is sent to service administrator about the activation of a new command. If the command is correct, it shall be activated within 1 business day (a relevant email is sent to the Partner). The Partner should:

- Prepare a script for verification of SMS codes;
- Prepare a script for generation of SMS codes;
- Integrate its www page with code verification.

- c. **Method 3** – When the User orders the code, justpay generates the code in its database and sends it back to the User. When the User enters the code on the Partner’s website, the Partner checks the correctness of the code with justpay. The following parameters must be defined with justpay:
- Number of SMS Premium to which the User shall send SMS message;
 - Length of the code;
 - Purpose of the code (in default setup code can be used by the User once);
 - The command is then accepted by clicking on ACCEPT and after that ACTIVATE.

As soon as the command is defined, information is sent to service administrator about the activation of a new command. If the command is correct, it shall be activated within 1 business day (a relevant email is sent to the Partner). The Partner should

- Prepare a script for verification of SMS codes;
- Integrate its www page with code verification.

3. To add a new number to the existing command:
 - Choose COMMAND section;
 - Opposite every command there is a link ADD NUMBER to the page where the number may be modified/added to a particular command;
 - Choose the number and accept the change by selecting OK.
4. To add a new command, follow the steps as in par. 2.
5. To update data and SMS traffic reports
 - a. Changes may be introduced in information provided during the registration process – go to PARTNER’S INFO section and insert necessary changes.
 - b. In REPORTS section the Partner may view the number of SMS messages and due fee, having defined the period, number or command of the Partner.

If an option is unavailable or inactive, you must obtain the acceptance or another action of the service administrator.
